Taking a look back, we see twelve-year-old Cliff helming a racing dinghy in the midst of a thunderstorm on the Vaal River. His father yells at him not to be a sissy, and he brings the boat back to shore alone. We then travel to London with his family escaping the tumult of Apartheid. He trains for the Olympics, but drops out, enrolling in the South African military where he subjected to harsh treatment and name calling Fokken Jood. On their honeymoon to Paris, Cliff says, *Merci Paris* for the best year of my life.

Drawing on a wealth of new material and period documents, the author of *The Young Hemingway* traces Ernest Hemingway's development from promising young novelist to a master during the thirties, illuminating his literary evolution and the people, places,
