**Public health, prevention and health improvement**

Looking at quality measures across five key areas (stop smoking services, sexual health, immunisation, childhood obesity and substance misuse), the majority of public health indicators continue to follow past trajectories. Differences in trends across local authorities are evident - for example, the most deprived areas had worsening trends in STI rates, but did demonstrate significantly better improvement in teenage pregnancy rates compared to the national trend.
