Then we can install Samba. I'm using prebuilt binaries, so we're using pkg here: pkg install samba41. It could be that the samba41 package is not available on your installation since you use a newer FreeBSD version like 12. In this case, just run pkg search samba and you will get a list of the available samba versions, like:

To write the FreeBSD/arm image to an SD card, use the dd (1) utility, replacing KERNEL with the appropriate kernel configuration name for the system. # dd if=FreeBSD-11.0-RELEASE-arm-armv6- KERNEL.img \ of=/dev/da0 bs=1m conv=sync. Be careful to make sure you get the target (of=) correct.
