In binocular vision, an organism has two eyes which are aligned so that their field of vision overlaps in part. This causes a slight parallax difference between the field of vision of each eye in the area of

overlap. The small binocular disparity is automatically interpreted by the brain as depth perception, and is capable of making very precise estimates of distance.
