Eyewitness war correspondent William Russell wrote in his despatch for The Times of 'a thin red streak topped with a line of steel', but in later accounts he used the 'Thin Red Line' phrase, which stuck in the public consciousness. The phrase remains in wide use today, often used colloquially to mean infantry (as in Terence Malik ' s 1999 film about US infantry in the Pacific in 1942) or any thinly-stretched group resisting greater forces ...

The Thin Red Line was an episode in the Battle of Balaclava on 25 October 1854, during the Crimean War. In this incident, around 500 men of the 93rd, aided by a small force of 100 walking wounded, 40 detached Guardsmen, and supported by a substantial force of Turkish infantrymen, led by Sir Colin Campbell, fired at the Russian cavalry. The ' thin red line ' was a group of 200 Highlanders flanked by 350 Ottoman (Turkish) soldiers who stood their line about 1 mile north of the town of Balaklava. Because there were not sufficient troops, the 93rd Regiment stood two men deep, which was far less than the four man deep regulation of the time.
